At the domain level, IPTA provides the domain software architecture and integration capability for multiple domain systems under the Secretary of the Air Force for Acquisition (SAF/AQX) umbrella. **SAF/AQX uses embedded IPTA acquisition expertise as advisers on policy and processes** to meet EITDR, DIACAP, SISSU and other mandates across the domain.

IPTA also provides executive and intermediate level high quality Program Management, Systems Engineering, and administrative services to the federal government including Department of Defense (DoD) clients in the areas of Weapon Systems Acquisition and Sustainment, Information Technology, International, and Advanced Technology Programs. System Metric and Reporting Tool (SMART)



Under the AFTAS Pro contract IPTA is invested in the development and sustainment of the web-based management tool designed for the U.S Air Force (USAF) Acquisition enterprise to streamline acquisition program methods and provide a universal standard for assessing program health and performance. The System Metric and Reporting Tool (SMART), is deployed across the USAF Acquisition and Logistics enterprises and has about 6,000 users. SMART promotes non-intrusive transparency into official USAF programs and provides reliable, immediate information for senior level decision making.

853rd Electronic Systems Group USAF (ELSG)

IPTA delivers program management support to the 853rd ELSG which touches all aspects of the National Airspace System acquisition process. IPTA provides critical support and council to the Group's leadership that not only forms the foundation but the structure for future acquisitions, innovation for new programs, more efficient procurement cycle, and the sound day-to-day operations of system program offices.
